reported percentages ranging from 20-35% in terms of the prevalence of childhood sexual abuse in gay men. Unfortunately, a lot of the papers are also looking at prevalence of risky behaviors so it may be a subset of a subset. So Dr. Drew's claims of universality may be overstated, or reflect the fact that Southern California is fucked up, or inherent problems with surveys or what have you. IAE, there's a much higher prevalence of childhood sexual abuse (typically by older men involving coercion or force) in gay men than in other groups. Not conclusive but certainly suggestive.
